INTRODUCTION

For the 2004-2005 School Year, the enrollment for the Williamsburg-James City County Public Schools has continued to increase. From the September 30, 2003 enrollment level of 8,959 students, the School Division experienced an increase of 443 additional students, resulting in a September 30, 2004 total of 9,402. This increase of 443 students equates to a growth rate of 4.94 percent, compared to 4.75 percent growth in 2003-2004. This increase in student enrollment also represents the highest one year increase in the history of the school division.

The updated information within these tables will serve as a partial basis for determining next year's enrollment projection, as well as projections for subsequent years. A great deal of other information is used to prepare these projections but the current year's experience will rank as a major source of data on which to predict future events.

As was the case in last year's report, this document provides detailed information about the composition of this year's enrollment, its dispersal among schools, and how this year's student population compares to the previous years. Other tables include such information as the percentage of students on the federal free and reduced lunch program at each school.

The table, entitled *2004-05 September 30 Enrollment* shows a breakdown of the enrollment between the City of Williamsburg and James City County and by race for each school and grade level. Other tables within this document provide more data about this breakdown, as well as race and gender statistics by grade level for each school, and actual class size at each school.

In the appendix, the table entitled *Enrollment/Staff Analysis* shows trends by grade and school for the past two years. It also has information about the average class size and number of teachers at each grade level in the elementary and middle schools. Finally, the analysis presents the variance between projected enrollment and actual enrollment.

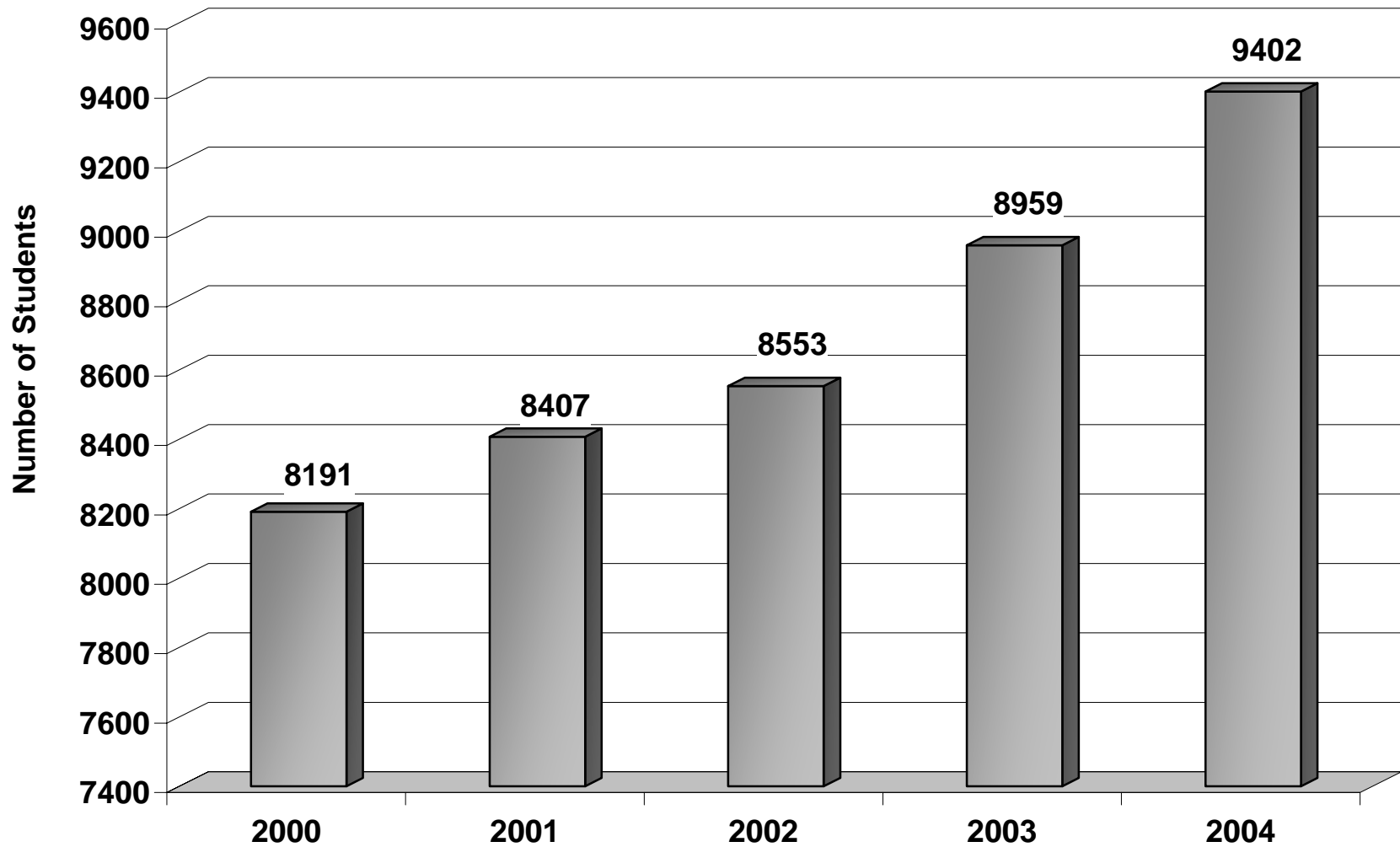

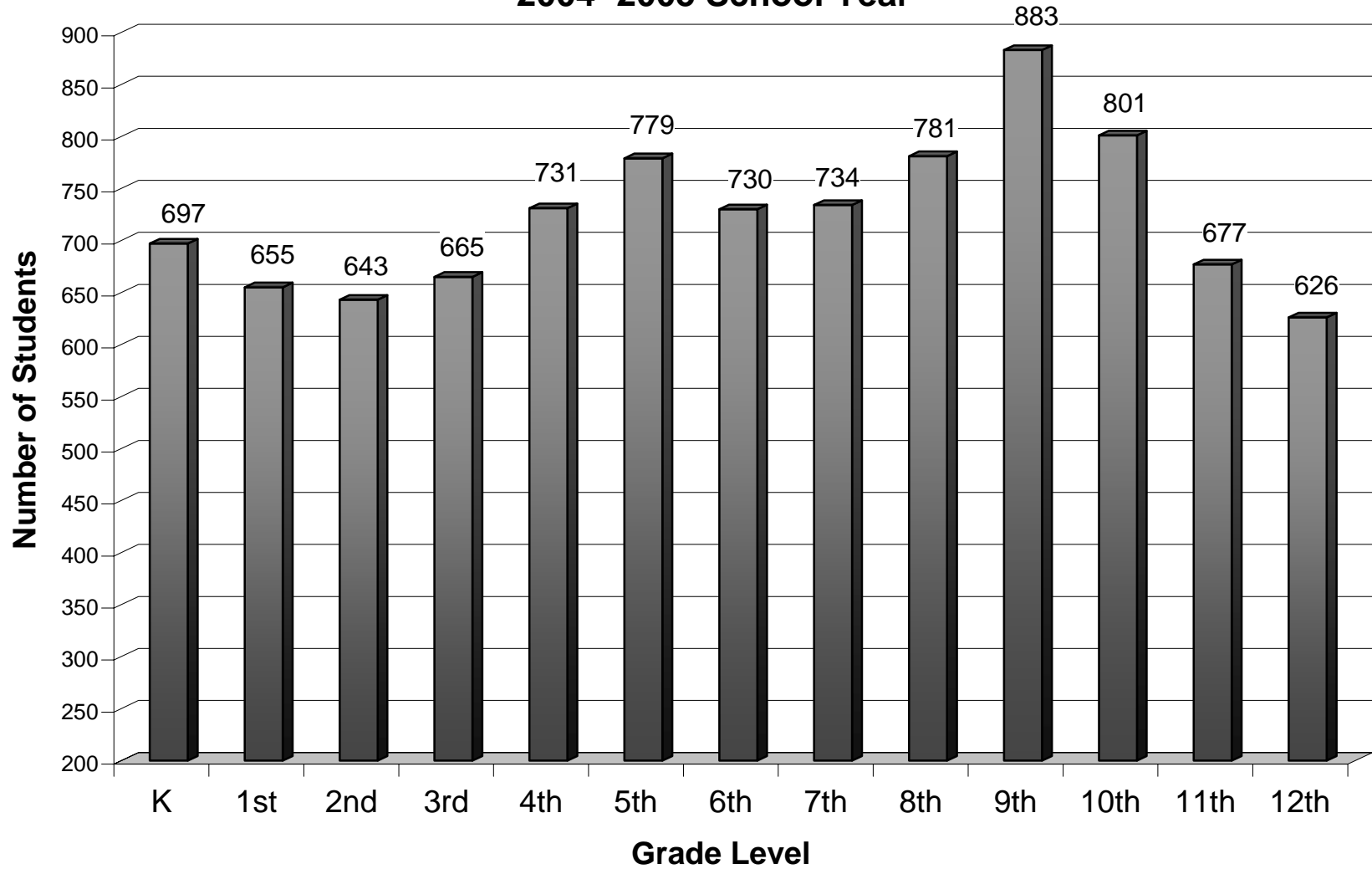

Growth in Enrollment by School

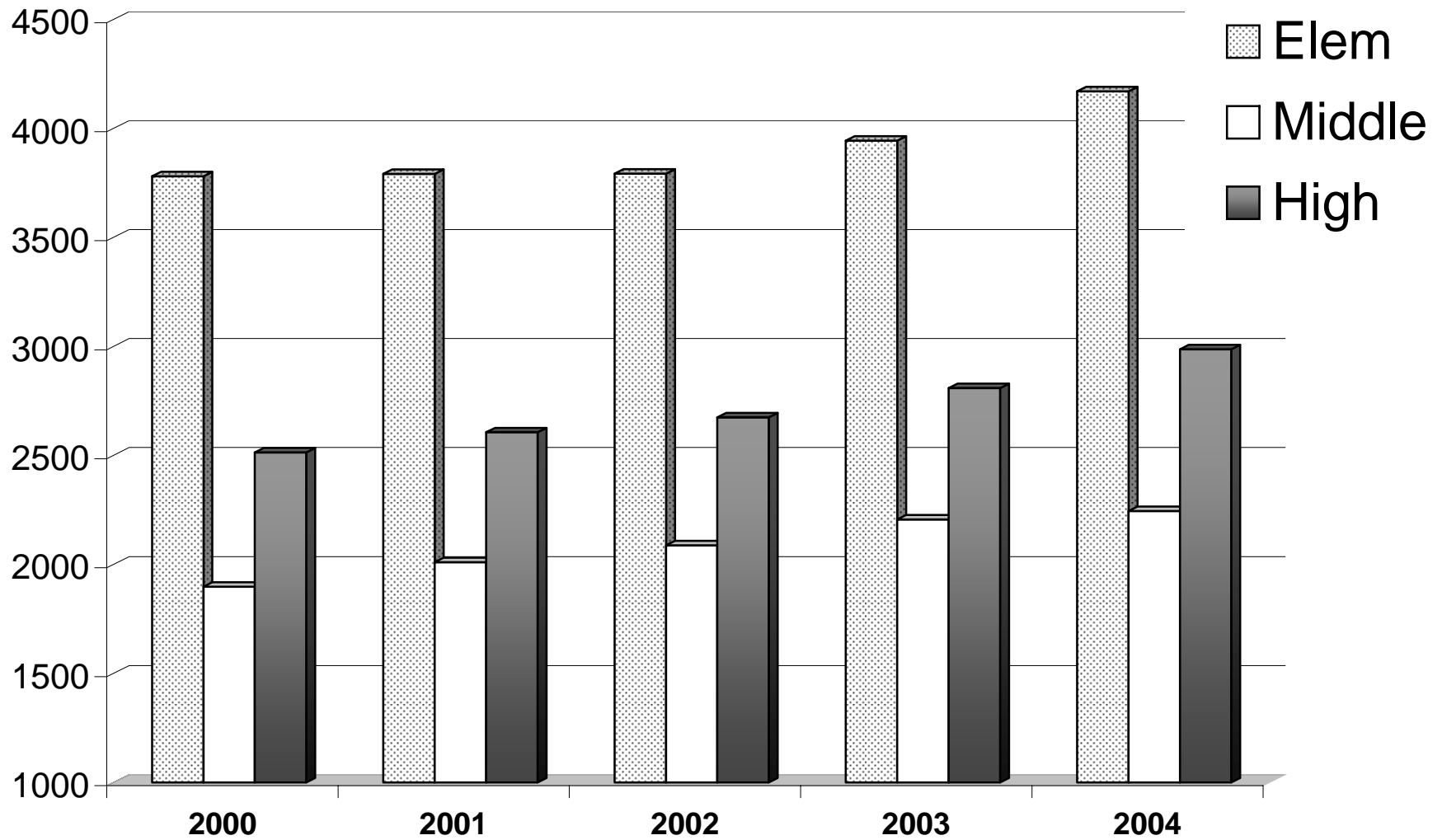

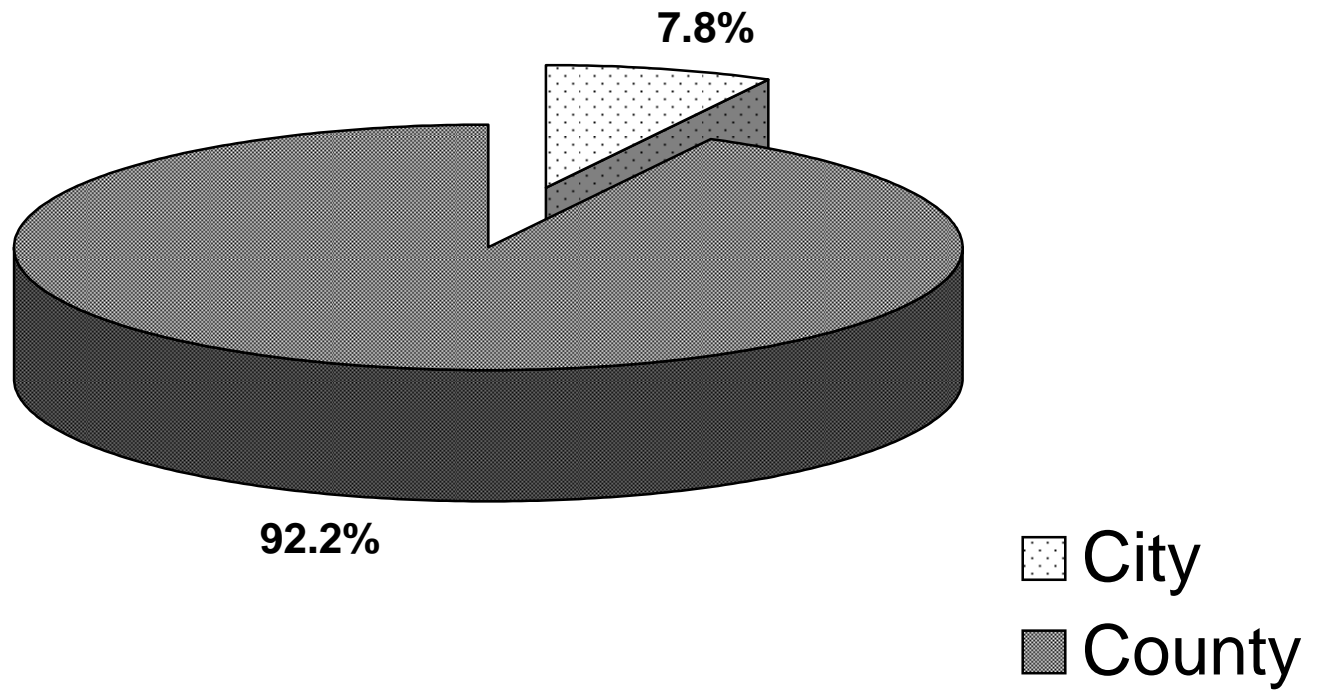
Growth in Total Enrollment

Five Year History



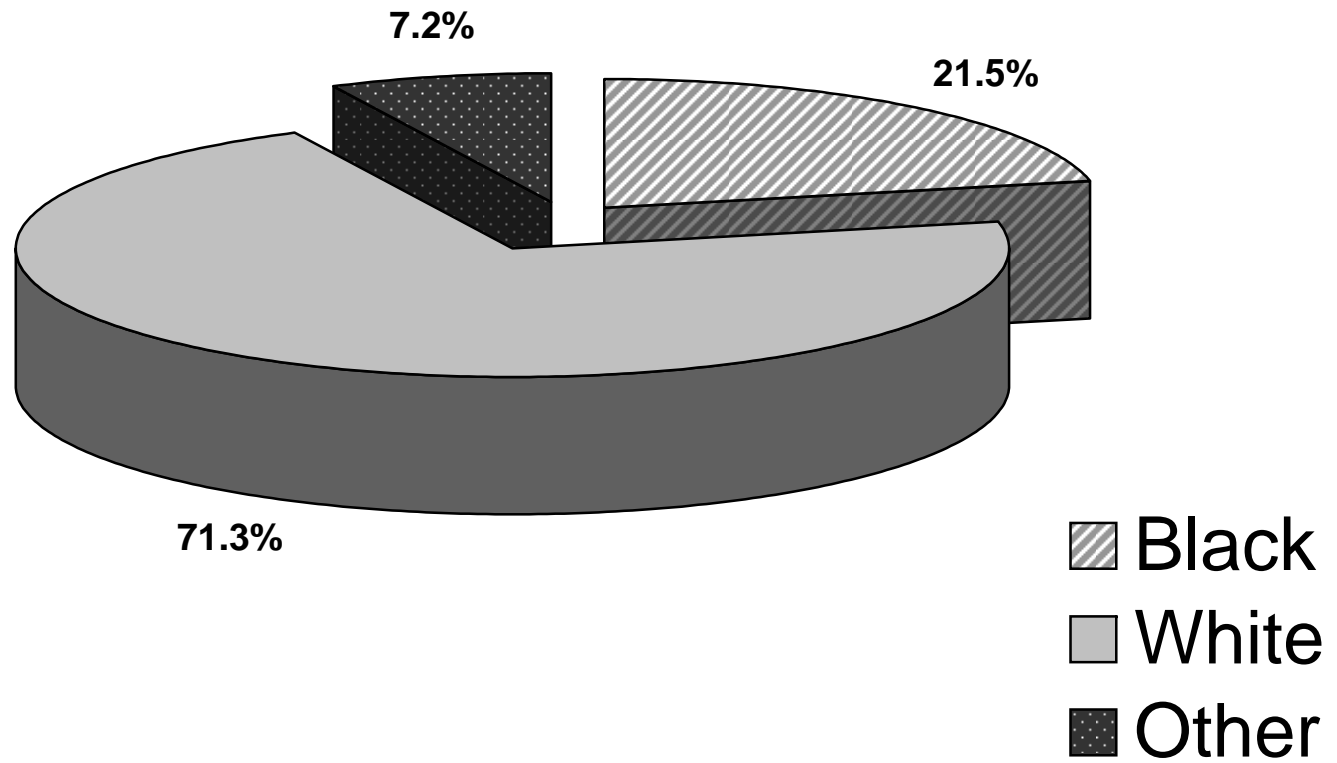
Enrollment by Jurisdiction

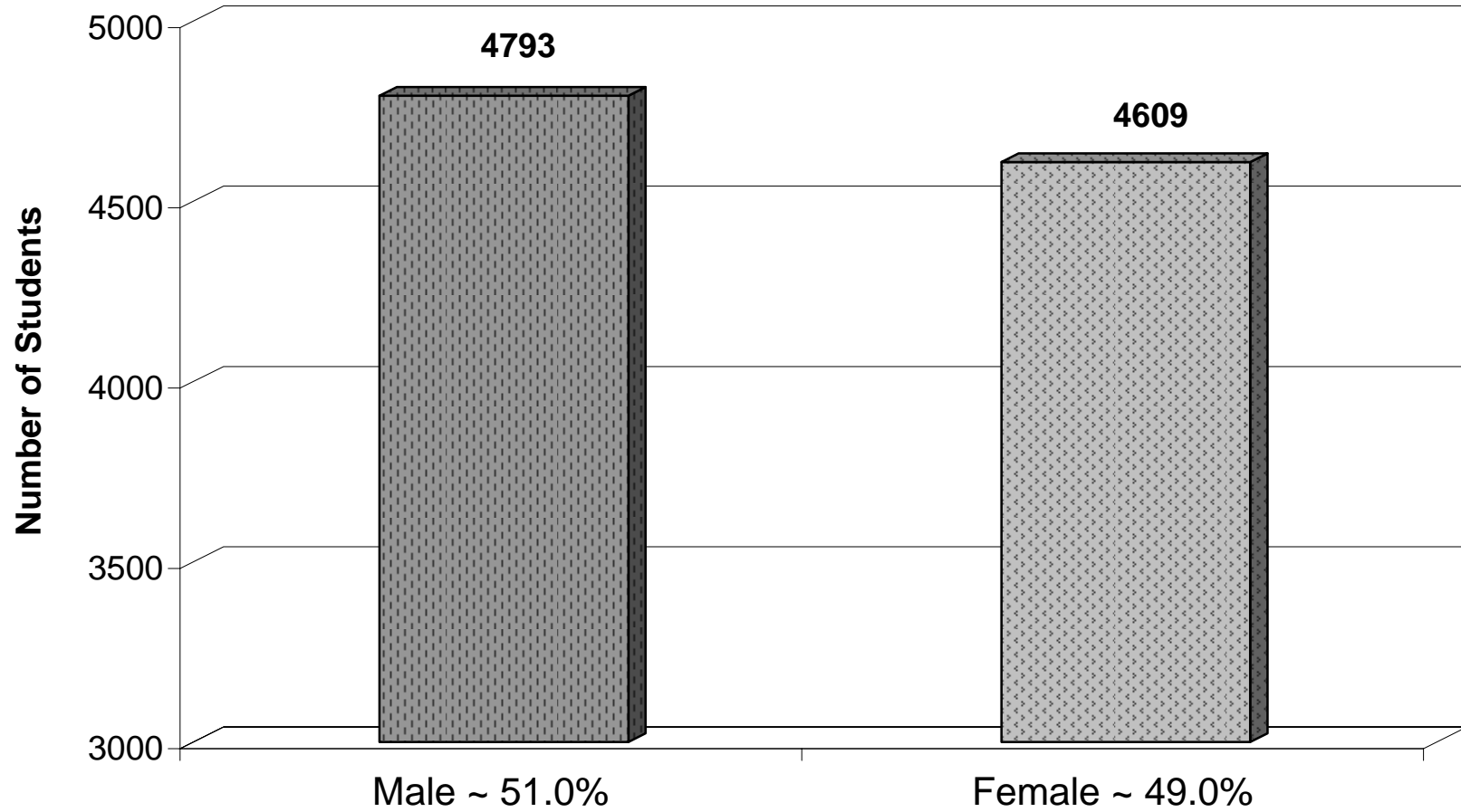
