## INTRODUCTION

For the 2011-2012 School Year, the enrollment for the Williamsburg-James City County Public Schools has continued to increase. From the September 30, 2010 K-12 enrollment level of 10,549 students, the School Division experienced an increase of 122 additional students, resulting in a September 30, 2011 K-12 total of 10,671. This increase of 122 students equates to a growth rate of 1.16 percent.

The updated information within these tables will serve as a partial basis for determining next year's enrollment projection, as well as projections for subsequent years. A great deal of other information is used to prepare these projections but the current year's experience will rank as a major source of data on which to predict future events.

This document provides detailed information about the composition of this year's enrollment, its dispersal among schools, and how this year's student population compares to the previous years. Other tables include such information as the percentage of students on the federal free and reduced lunch program at each school. A separate chart showing Special Education numbers is also enclosed.

The table, entitled *September 30 Enrollment 2011-2012 School Year* shows a breakdown of the enrollment between the City of Williamsburg and James City County and by race for each school and grade level. Other tables within this document provide more data about this breakdown, as well as race and gender statistics by grade level for each school, and actual class size at each school.

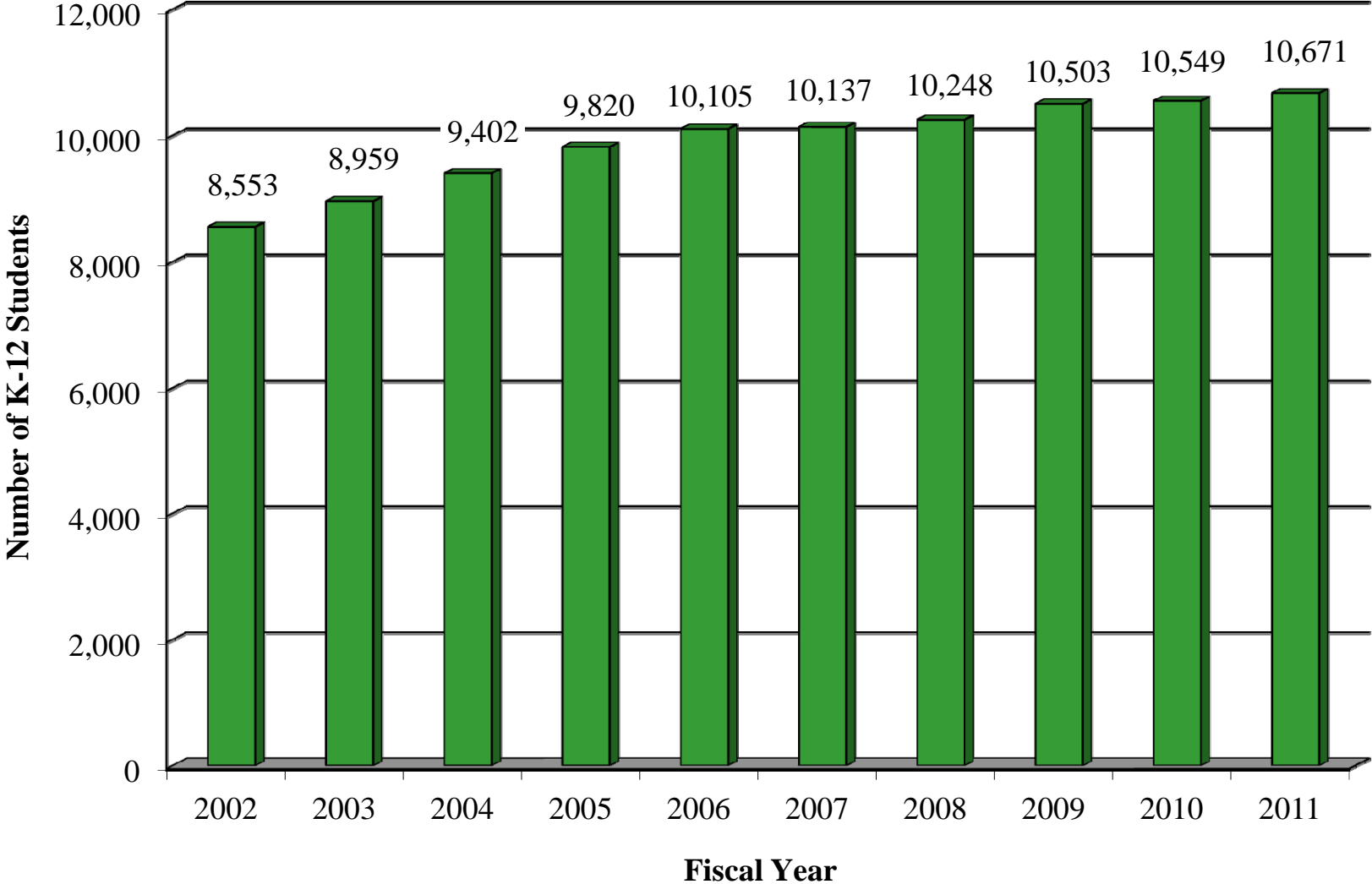

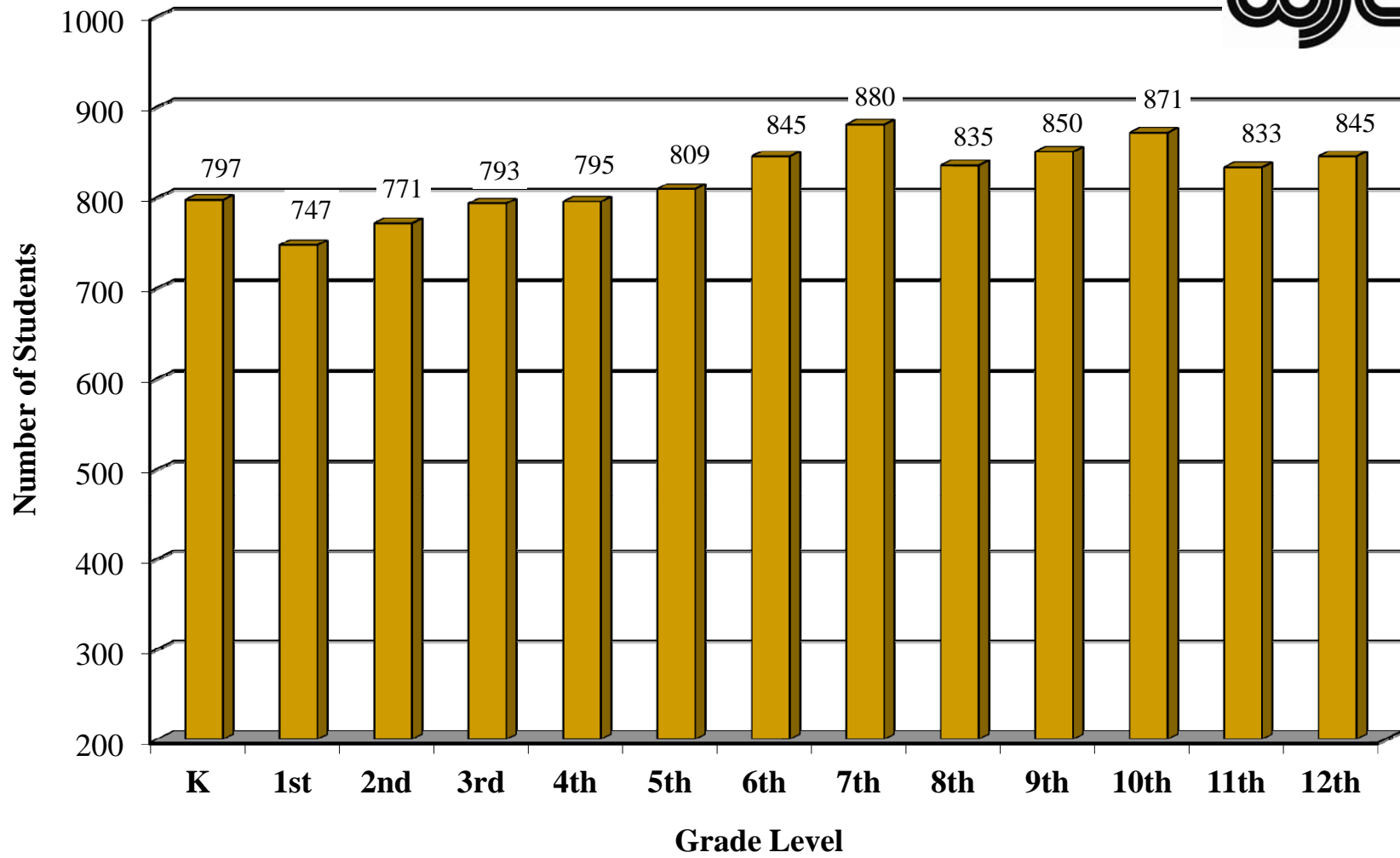
# Growth in Total Enrollment by Year

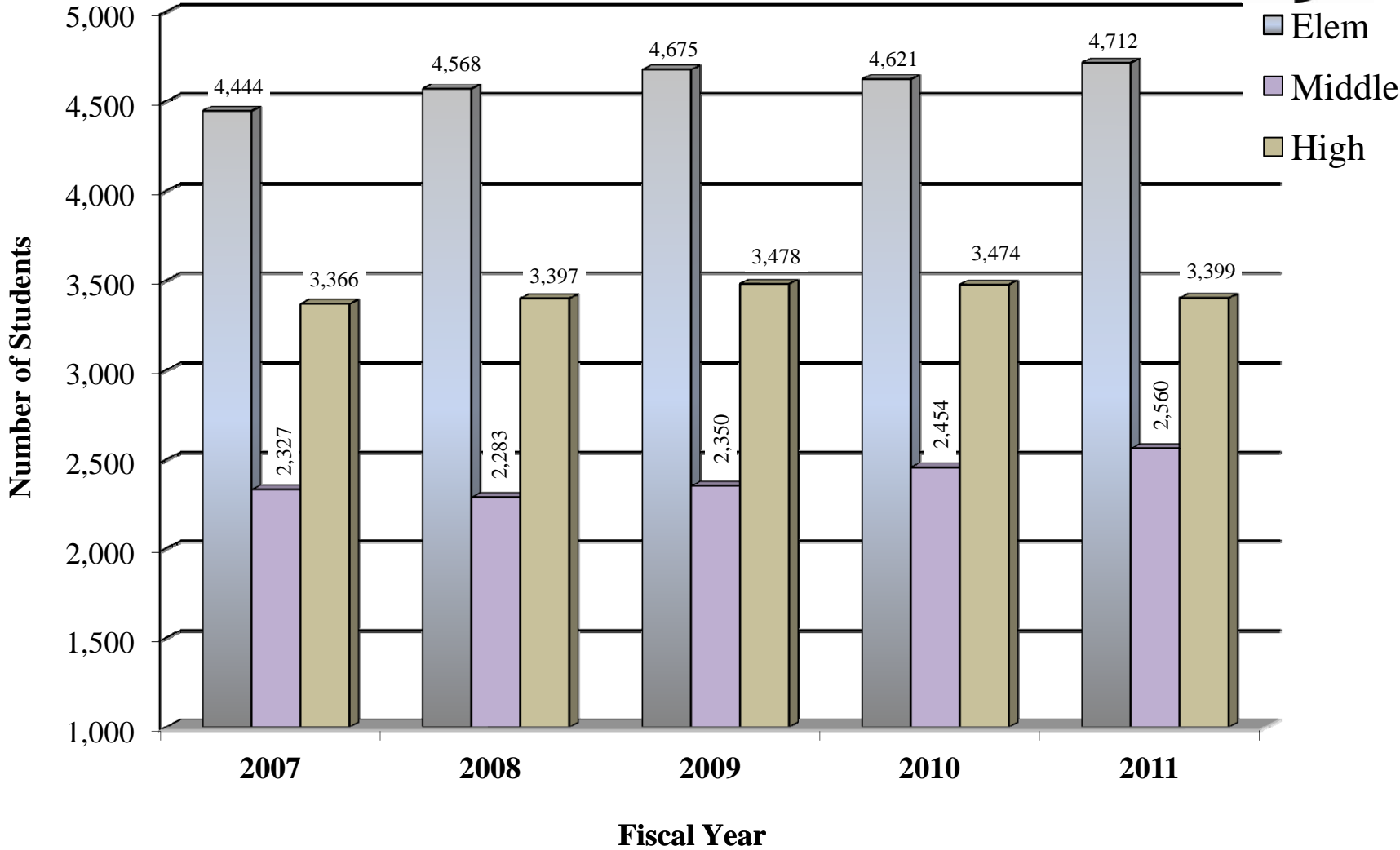

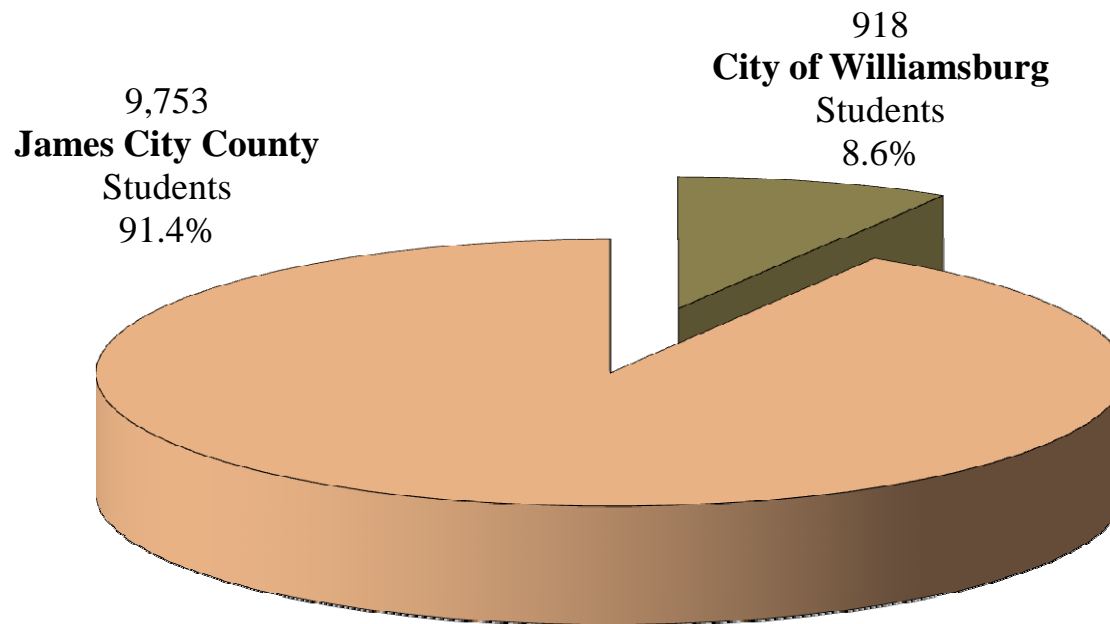
September 2007: Matoaka Elementary School and Warhill High School both opened. (There was no 12th Grade class at WHS in 2007-2008)

September 2010: J Blaine Blayton Elementary opened. James Blair Middle closed and Lois Hornsby Middle School opened.

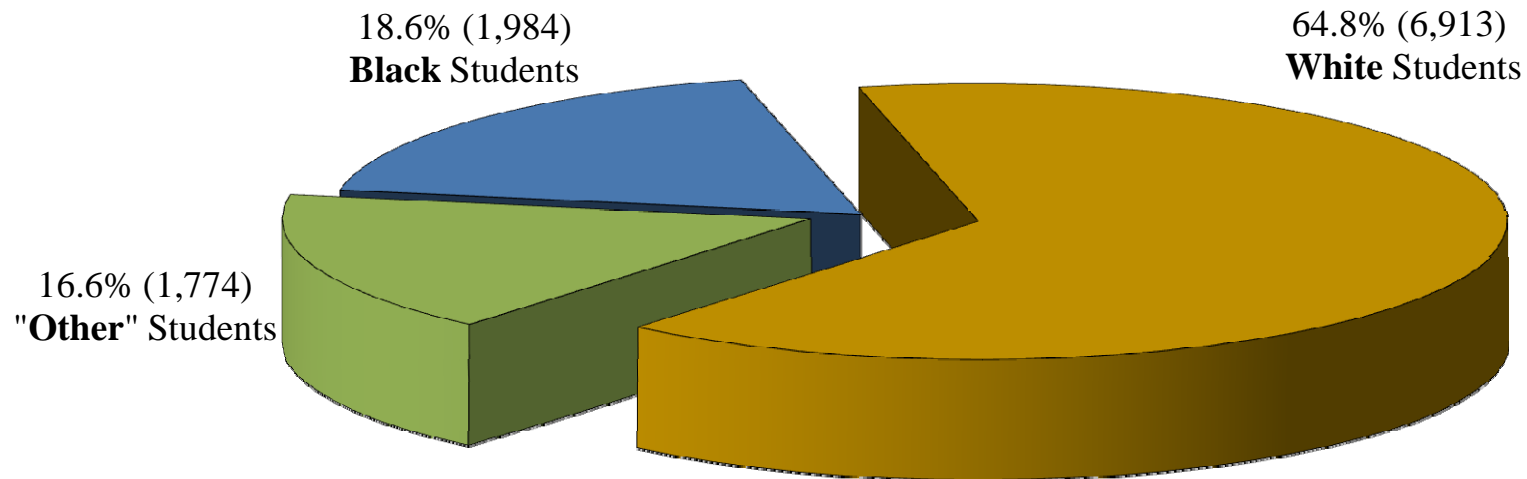
# Growth in K-12 Enrollment Five Year History



## K-12 Enrollment by Jurisdiction 2011-2012 School Year



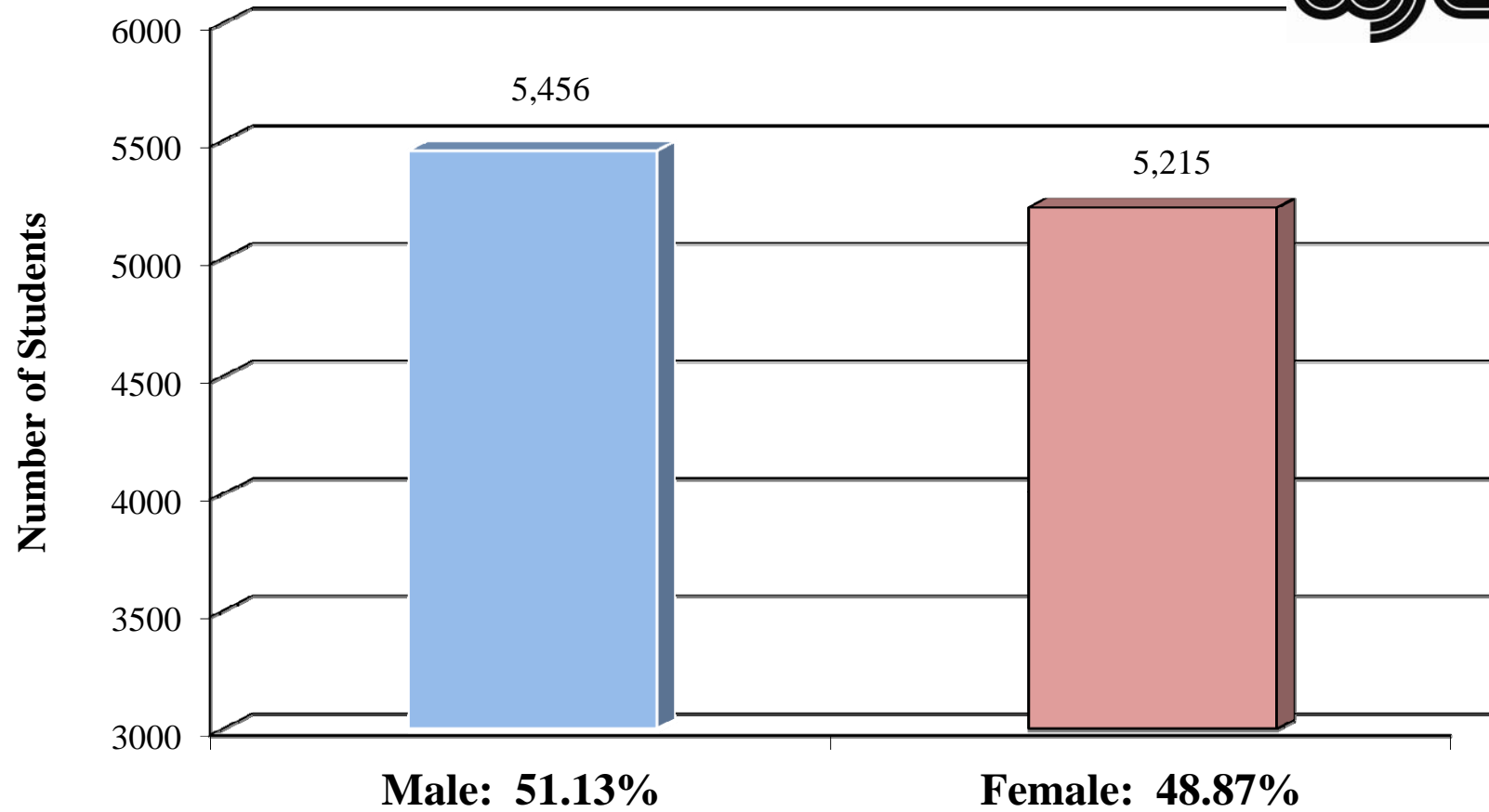
## K-12 Enrollment by Ethnicity 2011-2012 School Year
