- ▶ The Agriculture program (AG)
 - Capacity 100 students
 - Located at Virginia Polytechnic Institute & State University
 - 4 weeks: June 26–July 23, 2011
- ▶ The Humanities program (HUM)
 - Capacity 200 students
 - Located at Radford University
 - 4 weeks: June 26–July 23, 2011
- ▶ The Math, Science, and Technology program (MST)
 - Capacity 160 students
 - Located at Lynchburg College
 - 4 weeks: July 3–July 30, 2011

Mentorship Programs

- ▶ Life Sciences and Medicine (LSM)
 - Capacity 30 students
 - Located at Virginia Commonwealth University
 - 4 weeks: July 3–July 29, 2011
- ▶ NASA/Langley Research Center Mentorship and the National Institute of Aerospace Mentorship (NASA/NIA)
 - Capacity 12 students
 - Located at Christopher Newport University with transportation to the mentorship site daily.
 - 4 weeks: June 26–July 23, 2011
- ▶ Virginia Institute of Marine Sciences (VIMS)
 - Capacity 6 students
 - Located at Christopher Newport University with transportation to the mentorship daily.
 - 4 weeks: June 26–July 23, 2011


Visual and Performing Arts

- ▶ capacity 200 students
- ▶ Located at Radford University
- ▶ 4 weeks: June 26–July 23, 2011

Timeline Notes

- ▶ October 2010 Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) web page displays all applications and guides.
- ▶ Early November Visual and Performing Arts students let school contacts know of their interest in the adjudication process and have draft copy of application completed.
- ▶ November 30th WJCC G/T coordinator submits names of selected students for the adjudication process.

Visual and Performing Arts cont.

- ▶ December 10, 2010 School Divisions receive individual adjudication schedules for distribution to students.
 - ▶ January 8th adjudication takes place for Visual and Performing Arts students at Christopher Newport University.

- ▶ Early January 2011 submit completed applications with teacher recommendations to division's selection committee.
 - ▶ Early February the division's selection committee reviews applications for the nominee selection.
 - ▶ April 20, 2011 each nominee will be notified of their admission status.
