- Ziploc bags, small or large

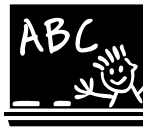
Please note that your child's teacher may request an additional supply that is not on this list. She will make you aware of that at Open House.

## 4th Grade Supply List (2011-2012)

- D-Ring binder (2 inch) – You may want to buy an extra binder at the beginning of school when they are on sale because most students need at least 2 per year.
- D-Ring binder (1 inch) – This will be used to keep materials used for SOL review.
- 3 Packs of white, wide-ruled paper (one for home and two for school)
- 2 pre-holed punched folders (with 2 pockets inside)  
(please label: Writing, Homework)
- 5 Subject dividers  
(please label: Social Studies, Science, Math, Language, Reading)
- 5 Composition books – NO SPIRALS  
(please label: Reading, Social Studies, Science, Math, Language)
- 24 (#2) Pencils with erasers (NO MECHANICAL PENCILS, NO PENS)
- 24 cap erasers
- 4 Yellow highlighter pens
- Crayons or colored pencils (24 ct.) - NO MARKERS
- Pencil pouch for binder (*required for binder checks*)
- Scissors
- 1 Roll transparent tape
- 24 glue sticks
- 2 Boxes of tissues (optional)
- 1 Pump bottle of liquid hand sanitizer (optional)
